Chartwells School Dining Services wants to ensure that your child is served healthy, well-balanced meals and your child enjoys what he/she eats. We strive to make the school lunch experience a special one. As you know, our lunch program operates on a pay as you go system. **“Charging” the cost of a lunch is not permitted.**

We also operate a new, computerized, ticket-less system. To pay ahead for these ticket-less lunches, you simply send in a check made out to the **Sharon School Lunch Program**. These funds are deposited into an account established for the use of your child. You may deposit any amount and your child uses a pin number to access the funds when paying for lunch. When putting money into this general account, you are allowing your child to buy lunch and snacks off the line only. (No vending snacks are allowed out of this account). Funds can carry over from year to year. If funds remain in your account at the end of the school year, you will receive a statement via your child, indicating any carry forward balance.

If you prefer your child not to buy snacks or second lunch please check the box below.
